**Smarter Working update** In recent months, the Smarter Working programme has been looking at our office requirements across NHS Grampian. Several teams have taken part in early adopter schemes, helping us understand exactly what we need. This has been extremely useful, and we are grateful for their support.

As we further embed smarter working, it is clear the layout of some of our office accommodation is not suited to that model. We are considering our options and have started early discussions with Aberdeenshire Council regarding office accommodation at Woodhill House. No decisions have been taken and any agreement would be subject to the organisation being satisfied the accommodation will meet our needs. We are in direct communication with those teams who may relocate; for all other office-based teams it is business as usual.
