

**School disruption - 24 November** Two teaching unions have confirmed plans to take industrial action next Thursday (24 November). Aberdeenshire Council have today announced all their schools will be closed that day; Aberdeen City and Moray Councils are providing further information directly to parents and carers. If you cannot put alternative childcare arrangements in place and your ability to attend work is therefore affected, it is important you have a conversation with your line manager to discuss the use of annual leave, parental leave, TOIL, working at home, or rearranging shifts as appropriate.

**Phishing emails** Our colleagues at National Services Scotland have let us know of an email circulating on behalf of MHRA and sent to the ISO or MDSO network (see below). This is believed to be a phishing attack and therefore recommend you:

- Follow local policy for suspected phishing attacks
