## **Progress/Achievements**

- New content 'Your Metal Health' published on Birth in Grampian website Your Mental Health Birth in Grampian (scot.nhs.uk)
- Grampian Perinatal and Infant Mental Health Collaborative (PIC) planning complete – first meeting takes place 22<sup>nd</sup> Jan 2024
- Staff and service users reviewing content of Infant Feeding tab on BiG website
- Maternity congratulatory card design winners selected and cards have gone to print ready for distributing from January 2024
- Family Nurse Practitioner and Health Visiting leads for each area included in local MVP membership
- Ongoing engagement with Muslim mums' group with 150+ members
- Moray Maternity expense claim process now electronic following feedback from the Moray & Banff MVP
- Second addition of NHSG & NHSH <u>Maternity Collaborative</u> Newsletter published.

## **Next Steps/Future Plans**

- Re-run of NHSG maternity survey on place of birth, mode of birth and induction of labour, to compare data and monitor progress
- Identify further areas of Birth in Grampian website for review
- Monitor effectiveness of elements of the Maternity Charter
- Working group to review antenatal education provision across
   Grampian established. Service users to be engaged around future service plans once current service mapping is complete.
- NHS Education for Scotland leading engagement with service users in January 2024 to support NHSG Maternity Service to review how trauma informed care is delivered.
